GOP lawmaker calls governor 'crazy'

DOVER — The GOP minority leader in the state House is blasting Gov. Jack Markell for comments the governor made after his proposed sports betting bill failed to win House passage.

Republican Rep. Richard Cathcart today angrily rejected Markell's assertion that opponents of the bill sided with the state's casino industry over the interests of state employees.

Markell said failure of the gambling bill will make it more difficult to reduce or eliminate proposed pay cuts for state employees, another piece of his plan to address a huge revenue shortfall for next year.

Cathcart said the two issues are unrelated, and that if Markell thinks solving the state's financial problems will be easy, he's "crazy."
