

## Delaware Senate Awaits Sports Betting Bill

**DOVER**, Del. (AP) - A Delaware sports betting bill now heads to the state Senate after it was resurrected by House lawmakers. After hours of closed-door negotiations, lawmakers passed the bill early Friday morning.

The NFL and other professional sports leagues, as well as the NCAA, oppose sports betting, saying it would tarnish the image of athletics and lure young people into gambling. And state lawmakers acknowledge they could face a legal challenge if the bill is enacted.

The bill calls for state officials and the casino industry to submit an initial proposal on table games within 75 days of enactment of the sports betting legislation, which still must win approval in the state Senate.
