Measure that could clear racino project stalls

Legislation that could clear the way for **Del Pointe** Resort & Casino is still pending in the House Gaming & Parimutuels Com-mittee and could die there as the General Assembly moves toward the end of ses-sion Tuesday, June 30.

Rep. John Viola, D- Newark, gaming committee chairman, said House Bill 194 had not been placed on the agenda for a hearing. He said he knows the legislation wasn't scheduled for a hearing because he's responsible for setting the agenda.

Viola said rumors that he cancelled the hearing or pulled the measure are absolutely false.

“ At this point in time, with four days of session left, no budget, and being 6 7, or 800 million dollars down and all kinds of things being discussed but nothing's
